## Victoria Kwasinski Artist Statement

**M**y work is an exploration of energy, rhythm and movement. I seek to create an abstracted visual interpretation of a thought, feeling, or idea through the interplay of color and form that is often interlinked and connected with line. I am intrigued with the power of the energetic and emotional response to the juxtaposition of various shapes and how color relationships can create a particular mood. Sometimes my work has a link to elements found in nature, and other times it is directly related to an idea or emotion. Most often, my process begins by spontaneously 'making marks' on the canvas. At some point, I usually connect to a specific thought or a particular emotion begins to take form. It is then that I dialogue, meditate, write and edit the painting to completion. My goal as a visual artist is to create an emotional response or rapport with the viewer, in hopes that I am speaking...without words...of the interconnection we share.

**Selected Biographical Information:** Victoria Kwasinski attended Colorado Institute of Art and went on to receive her Bachelor of Fine Arts degree from Rocky Mountain College of Art and Design where she graduated class valedictorian. Her love of art has been a lifetime journey that began with her first award at the age of seven. She has over twenty years of experience as a Professional Artist and has worked as a Corporate Graphic Artist, Freelance Illustrator, Gallery Owner, Fine Artist and Art Instructor.

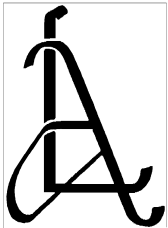
