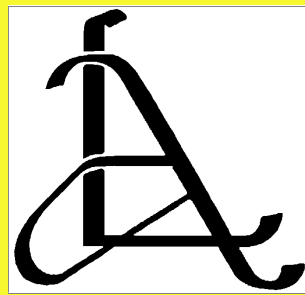

Need a Ride to LAA Meetings?????

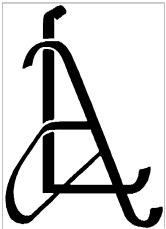
