Dear Artists,

I want to invite you to join me the weekend of January 23-25 as I teach a class on color. The workshop will be held in Longmont and will run from 8:30 am to 4:30 pm Friday and Saturday, and Sunday

from 1:00 to 4:30. Too often we jump into this wonderful world without doing the homework which will give us a better understanding of what we are doing. Of all the areas of painting, color in all it's variety, stands tallest to me. Devoting a weekend to it will enable us to explore this area in more depth.

In the workshop I will be presenting material I have gleaned over the years from my teachers and from my experience. My introduction to the world of color as relates to the painter came when I was required to take an introductory painting class in college with Dan McCaw. He opened my eyes in a wonderful way to painting, and part of the reason I am painting today is because of what he taught about color. The material he taught me will be part of the mix. We will also go farther in depth with the core knowledge necessary for understanding how to isolate and mix any color - the color wheel. Because the class will be held in January, we will plan to remain indoors with lecture and exercises in the morning (yes, we will be painting "little squares") and application as we paint from still life, photos, and/or the clothed model, in the afternoon.

I would say this class is most suitable to intermediate and beginning painters, but more advanced students are welcome as well. The material is applicable to painting any subject.

The cost is \$180. There may be an additional model fee of \$5 - \$10 which will be determined in the future and can be paid day-of. The class will be limited to 12 students. A \$20 non-refundable deposit will reserve your spot, with the balance due by January 9th, or you may pay in full now. Please mail payment to: 3843 Columbia Drive, Longmont, CO 80503.
