Member Interview Jennifer Strand

Jennifer Strand is possibly the only LAA member who can actually speak with her hair. A naturally enthusiastic person, her growing animation about a subject sets her blond hair flashing about, tracing ideas in the air.



Jennifer is on the LAA board, and is Chair of LCC (Louisville Cultural Council) which presents Louisville's musical summer Thursday evenings in the park, lectures, French Bistro music, and whatever artistic endeavors are likely to ignite the town's interest.

For her own artwork, her studio is set up with both a large easel and a writing desk. A typical approach to creative moments is to paint first, and then move on to writing.

She's particularly interested in abstracts and landscapes in watercolor and pastels, and her latest piece developed as a really satisfying work---until she decided to add just that one little shadow. And then another little shadow. She tries not to get so furiously involved that the joy is drained off when flubs happen.

Husband David is a psychologist, and one wonders if having such a person handy isn't perfect for an artist. "He's a wonderful listener," she says.

Traveling, though, she says, is what she's best at, and she's just begun exploring ways to engage in short term tour directing, in perhaps week-long bites. Might we suggest an LAA group tour?
