

Member Interview Kim Roller

If you listen carefully, you may detect a slight hint of a southeastern accent. That's because her dad, then employed by IBM, was transferred and moved the family from Kentucky (where Kim spent her first 19 years) to Colorado. The Colorado years have brought a fair share of ups and downs, challenges and victories, and interesting twists and turns... all contributing to the personality we know as Kim Roller. Her no-nonsense personal style, strong athleticism, gentle sense of humor, and infectious laugh make Kim someone who's fun to be around. These qualities are, not surprisingly, seen clearly reflected in her paintings.

After finishing high school a year early, Kim began her college education in western Kentucky, took a turn through CSU, then moved on to CU-Boulder. She earned degrees in Community Recreation, Physical Education (with a teaching credential), and Kinesiology. As her career unfolded, these three majors turned out to be the perfect preparation for what she would be doing. Prior to launching a career in teaching, Kim had a small business doing



fitness testing for local city recreation departments. Driven by her entrepreneurial nature, Kim's business was on the cutting edge of that field, and coupled with her wise decision to incorporate scientific findings into her work, the enterprise was ahead of its time as well as credible. Later she worked for the American Diabetes Association as an exercise specialist, and that led to her becoming a physical education teacher.

During her many years of teaching physical education, she was an avid soccer player and developed a strong sense of community with her fellow players. In midlife, Kim began to experience back problems and eventually underwent two surgeries, each of which required long periods of rehab and no soccer playing. The loss of soccer as a hobby and the loss of her soccer community eventually resulted in Kim's discovery of art! Kim began studying art with well-known LAA teachers Jane Friday and Susannah VanDyke. As her painting style has emerged over time, Kim has become known for her colorful, unique, sports scenes on canvas. Given her background and training in sports, is it any surprise that Kim's artworks reflect that passion?

A few years later, she joined LAA where she has jumped in with boundless energy and contributed to the local art community in numerous meaningful ways. She co-managed the fall member show with Camilla Pratt in 2014. This, she says, involved a steep learning curve since both co-managers were brand new to the role. At that time, the fall show was held at the Louisville Recreation Center and featured significant quantities of jewelry and holiday crafts, making it a large, complicated challenge of a show on which to "cut one's teeth." The following year, Kim was the lead manager of the same show. This year, Kim was part of a four woman team that organized, reinvented, and successfully produced LAA's annual Theme Show at East Simpson Coffee Company. The project entailed considerable teamwork, thinking outside the box, and lots of adventurous spirit to create. But the team pulled it off and got resounding praise from all involved. Maybe a repeat performance is in the cards for 2022's Theme Show?

Around the time Kim became active in LAA, she also started entering art shows and exhibiting her work through LAA's Art in Public Places program. Her successes with these pursuits have re-ignited Kim's entrepreneurial spirit, leading her to venture farther afield in marketing her artwork with an eye toward appealing to sports enthusiasts as potential customers. Crested Butte, Winter Park... get ready for Kim to roll out her creations!

As I've gotten to know Kim through LAA's Plein Janes/Joes program and through working together on the Theme show's planning committee, I've observed in her approach to things the principle of drawing from one's own life experiences, not only in living life, but also applying these learnings to one's artwork. Even more inspiring has been Kim's example of diligence. She paints every day, something I aspire to but haven't yet put into practice.
