Entries: Limited to 1 entry per young artist

Media: Two-dimensional watercolor, oil, acrylic, ink, pencil, Crayola, photography, mixed media, handmade paper, etc. Three-dimensional work could include but is not limited to sculpture, pottery, etc

Please no school class xerox copied projects, original work from school is acceptable.

The Children's library does not have enough room or the ability to hang framed work. Each piece of matted work must have a hanger on the back.

Please put the artist's name and age on the back of each painting, drawing etc. Three-dimensional artwork must have the artist's name and age on the bottom of the piece.

Each year, 3 pieces of artwork will be chosen by the library staff to hang in the library for the year.

Delivery: All artwork must be delivered to the Louisville Public Library, Children's department on March 3 between 3:00 and 5:30 pm.

Pick up artwork: Artist/parents must pick up their work when the show is over on March 31st between 3:00 pm and 5:30 pm. If you are not able to pick up your art, please arrange for it to be gathered by someone else.

Awards: Participation ribbons will be given to every artist.
