## For Artists from 4 to 18 Years Old

- Matted 2-Dimensional pieces and 3-dimensional Original art entries will be accepted. No duplicated art sheets
- **Entry Form** must be delivered or mailed by February 28<sup>th</sup> to the Children's Department, Louisville Library, 951 Spruce Street, Louisville, CO 80027 Questions call 303-665-6093
- **Delivery** for all artist's creations is March 2<sup>nd</sup> from 3:00 pm to 5:30 pm at the Louisville Public Library Children's Department

**Two Dimensional Art Work** must be matted only, with a solid board backing, such as form board (Standard size mats available at craft stores). Each piece **MUST** have a picture hanger attached that will **support** the child's piece. Oil or acrylic paintings on stretched canvas must have wires for hanging (2 screw on bars with a wire attached to the back).

- **Artist's name and age** must be clearly written **on the back** of art work or on the bottom of 3-D entries.
- **Opening Reception** will be held on Thursday March 3rd at the First Floor Meeting Room, Louisville Public Library from 5:30 to 7:30 pm. Professional Artist's demonstrations, music, door prizes for participants, and refreshments provided. Door prizes drawn between 6:00 to 6:30 pm. **Must be present to win.**
- **The Youth Spring Art Show** is sponsored in collaboration with the Louisville Public Library, the Louisville Art Association, Louisville Cultural Council, and Boulder County SCFD. **Participating Artists** must pick up their work at the Children's Department, Louisville Public Library on Thursday, March 31st from 3:00 pm to 5:30 pm. **If you are unable to collect your art, please make arrangements for someone to do so for you.**

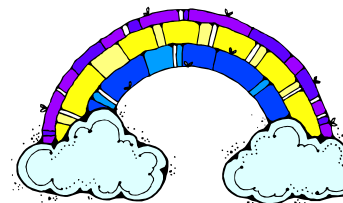

**Entries:** Limited to 1 entry per young artist

**Media:** Two dimensional watercolor, oil, acrylic, ink, pencil, crayola, photography, mixed media, handmade paper, etc. Three dimensional work could include but is not limited to sculpture, pottery, etc

**Please no school class zerox projects, original work from school is okay**

Two dimensional art work must be matted (standard mats can be found at local craft stores) and backed with something like foam core board, not framed, as the Children's library does not have enough room or the ability to hang framed work. Each piece of matted work must have a hanger on the back that will support the weight of the piece. Oil and acrylic paintings that are on stretched canvas must have wires for hanging. **Please put the artist's name and age on the back of each painting, drawing etc. Three-dimensional artwork must have the artist's name and age on the bottom of the piece.**

**Delivery:** All art work must be delivered to the Louisville Public Library, Children's department on March 2nd between 3:00 and 5:30

**Pick up artwork:** Artist/parents must pick up their work when the show is over on March 31st between 3:00 pm and 5:30 pm. **If you are not able to pick up your art, please arrange for it to be gathered by someone else. There is not a place to store pieces that are left.**

**Awards:** Participation ribbons will be given to every artist. A drawing for participant prizes will be during the reception. Must be present to win.
